

National Motor Freight Classification (NMFC) Changes

Are you ready for the upcoming **NMFC changes** taking effect this year?

The first change, called “Docket 2025-1”, is set for implementation on **July 19, 2025**, while the second change, “Docket 2025-2”, is tentatively scheduled to be released for review on August 28, 2025.

What’s Changing?

Docket 2025-1 changes aim to accomplish the following major NMFC improvements:

- Standardize the density scale for LTL freight with no handling, stowability, and liability issues
- Unique identifiers for freight with special handling, stowability, or liability needs
- Condensed and modernized commodity listings
- Improved usability of the ClassIT classification tool

How Can You Prepare?

With these changes occurring industry-wide, SEFL customers can prepare by leveraging current NMFTA and SEFL resources.

- **Bypass all NMFC Item Number requirements and changes by transitioning to dimensional-based **Dynamic Pricing** – contact your Account Manager for details**
