Shipping Options For Mexico:

1. Door-to-Door Mexico -

The shipment moves between the U.S. and Mexico from pickup to delivery. Prior to shipping, this must be arranged with the customs broker of your choice (SEFL LTL rates are not associated with Broker/Freight Forwarder fees).*

2. Domestic -

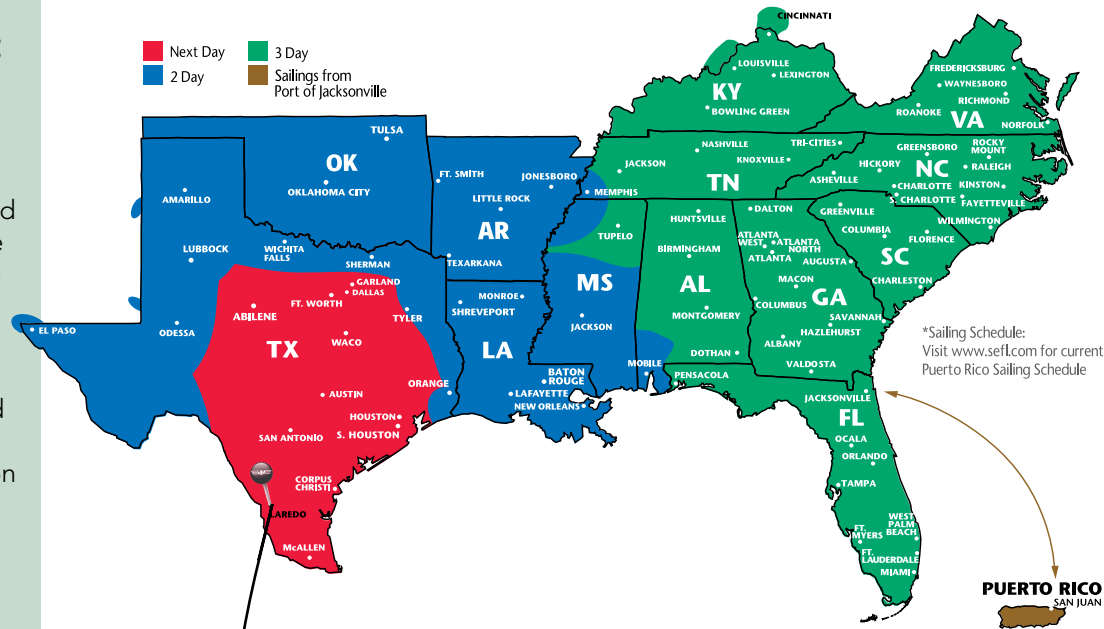
The shipment moves between you and your broker/forwarder at the border. SEFL only handles the domestic portion of the shipment, and your broker / forwarder handles the shipment the rest of the way to delivery in Mexico.

A: The Importer of Record (IOR) must establish a customs broker in advance of shipping, as the application process can take some time. The shipper should include the broker's name and contact information on the Bill of Lading and all relevant customs documentation. A shipper must know the customs broker prior to shipping their freight.

B: U.S. to Mexico brokerage requires a US based broker located in Laredo, Texas as well as a Mexican broker to clear the shipment prior to the freight crossing into Mexico. The U.S. shipper can typically secure needed broker information from their customer or IOR in Mexico.

C: Mexico to U.S. brokerage requires both a U.S. and Mexico broker. The Mexico broker will typically work on behalf of the exporter in Mexico; the U.S. broker will typically work on behalf of the IOR in the U.S.
